TRAVEL TIPS:

- Roll socks up and put into your shoes to maximize suitcase space.
- Pack many thinner layers rather than one thick layer.
- Wear your heaviest/largest shoes on the plane to save space in your luggage.
- If you have a packable down jacket, bring it in your carry-on or purse to use as a make-shift pillow!
- Stick to similar colors/metals to re-wear or mix-and-match outfits (like all gold accessories, or black and white themed outfit pieces, for exmaple.)
- Bring a bottle of clear nail polish if you plan to wear tights or hose (just a dab will stop snags and tears!)
- Be sure to check the dresscode for your cruiseline, just to be safe. That way you'll know to bring more or less formal/dressy clothing depending on where you and your companions choose to spend time.
- Chip clips can come in handy - most room doors are magnetic, so you can hang up docs, necklaces, etc.
